Promotion Information

What is Promotion at Mosaic?

At Mosaic we believe it is important for our kids and teens to learn about Jesus in a way that makes sense to them. So, for all of our age levels, from nursery through High School, we have curriculum and plans that are geared towards their specific ages. At the beginning of each summer, we promote your kids & students into the class that matches their Fall grade. This allows your child to get to know their classmates at church and start to build relationships with peers they could be attending school with for the upcoming year.

Things for you to know:

Promotion will happen from Pre-K through High School. In the Fall, if your child is entering one of the grades listed below, they will promote to a new class.

- Kindergarten
- 2nd grade
- 4th grade
- 5th grade (Club 56 – Located at Kings St. Café)
- 7th & 8th grade (Mosaic Middle – Located at the Sub Station)
- 9th – 12th grade (Mosaic High – Located at Kings St. Café on Thursdays @ 6:30)

If your child is entering any of the grades below, they will continue in the same class/space they have been attending currently.

- 1st grade
- 3rd grade
- 6th grade



Kids Promotion FAQ's

How/When does Nursery Promotion happen?

- When your child turns 3, they automatically enter the Pre-K room.

My child is 5, but not starting Kindergarten in August. Will they promote?

- No. Your child will stay within the Pre-K classroom until they are entering Kindergarten.

My child is entering 1st or 3rd grade and not changing classrooms. What does this mean?

- The curriculum that Mosaic Kids uses is based on grade and some grades are combined. Meaning, even though your child is entering a new grade, they will not always enter a new classroom.

How does promotion work for Mosaic Kids that attend Thursday services?

- Children entering Kindergarten will move downstairs to the K-4th space. This looks a little different than a Sunday morning.

My child will be in 5th or 6th grade in August. What are the biggest changes between Mosaic Kids and Club 56?

- On Sunday mornings, your 5th or 6th grader will meet their leaders near the Youth Door, located to the right of the Welcome Desk. They will check in there, but unlike Mosaic Kids, they will not receive a sticker. After check-in, they will join the worship service and can choose to sit with you or with their peers in the Youth section, located at the front right of the stage. Following the worship service, they will have connection time with their leaders and participate in a guided lesson. At the end of the service, please meet your child back in the lobby near the Youth Door for pick-up.



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Youth Promotion FAQ's

My child will be in 7 or 8th grade in August. What differences are there between Club 56 and Mosaic Middle?

- On Sunday mornings, 7th and 8th graders meet their leaders near the Mosaic Youth door (to the right of the Welcome Desk) before the worship service. Together, they head into the worship space, sitting in the front right section. After worship, the group moves to the Sub Station for their weekly lesson and connection time. You can pick up your student in the Lobby after the service.

My child will be in high school (9th–12th) in August. When do they meet?

- Mosaic High School meets weekly on Thursdays at 6:30p.m. Students check in when they arrive and have time to connect with others before heading into worship. They sit together in the front left section of the worship center. After worship, the group moves next door to King Street Café for teaching and small groups.
- On Sundays, high schoolers are encouraged to either volunteer or attend the main service. If your student is interested in volunteering, they can speak with Pastor Joe for more details.

How does Club 56 (5th–6th) and Mosaic Middle (7th–8th) work for those who attend on Thursday?

- On Thursdays, 5th–8th-grade students meet their leaders at the Youth Door for check-in (note: they will no longer receive a sticker as they did in Mosaic Kids). Unlike Sundays, when these groups usually meet separately, 5th–8th graders combine for the Thursday evening service. After check-in, they join the worship service together, where they can sit with their leaders and peers or with you. After worship, leaders guide the students downstairs to the Mosaic Game Room for their lesson and connection time. You can meet your student back in the Lobby after the service.
