## Promotion Information

### **What is Promotion at Mosaic?**

At Mosaic we believe it is important for our kids and teens to learn about Jesus in a way that make sense to them. So, for all of our age levels, from nursery through High School, we have curriculum and plans that is geared towards their specific ages. At the beginning of each summer, we promote your kids & students into the class that matches their Fall grade. This allows your child to get to know their classmates at church and start to build relationships with peers they could be attending school with for the upcoming year.

### **Things for you to know:**

Promotion will happen from Pre-K through High school. In the Fall, if your child is entering one of the grades listed below, they will promote to a new class.

- Kindergarten
- 2nd grade
- 4th grade
- 5th grade (Club 56 - Located at Kings St. Café)
- 7th & 8th grade (Mosaic Middle - Located at the Sub Station)
- 9th - 12th grade (Mosaic High - Located at Kings St. Café on Thursdays @ 6:30)

If your child is entering any of the grades below, they will continue in the same class/space they have been attending currently.

- 1st grade
- 3rd grade
- 6th grade

## FAQ's

### **How/When does Nursery Promotion happen?**

- When your child turns 3, they automatically enter the Pre-K room.

### **My child is 5, but not starting Kindergarten in August. Will they promote?**

- No. Your child will stay within the Pre-K classroom until they are entering Kindergarten.

### **My child is entering 1st or 3rd grade and not changing classrooms. What does this mean?**

- The curriculum that Mosaic Kids uses is based on grade and some grades are combined. Meaning, even though your child is entering a new grade, they will not always enter a new classroom.

### **How does promotion work for Mosaic Kids that attend Thursday services?**

- Children entering Kindergarten will move downstairs to the K-4th space. This looks a little differently than a Sunday morning.

### **My child will be in 5th or 6th grade in August. What are the biggest changes between Mosaic Kids and Club 56?**

- On a Sunday morning your 5 or 6th grade student will meet their leaders near the youth door. (Located to the right of the Welcome Desk) They will check-in there but will no longer receive a sticker as they did in Mosaic Kids. They will enter King Street Cafe with all 5th & 6th graders. They will then have connection time with their leaders and a guided lesson. You will meet your 5 & 6th grader back in the lobby near the Youth door after the service.

# Mosaic Youth Promotion

## FAQ's

### **My child will be in 7 or 8th grade in August. What differences are there between Club 56 and Mosaic Middle?**

- On Sunday morning your 7 or 8th grade student will meet their leaders near the Mosaic Youth door (Located to the right of the Welcome Desk) before the worship service. They will proceed into the worship space (Right front section). After worship, they will head over together to the Sub Station for their weekly lesson and connection time. You will meet your youth back in the Lobby after service.

### **My child will be in high school (9th-12th) in August. When do they meet?**

- The weekly meeting for Mosaic High School is on Thursdays at 6:30pm. High school students and leaders will meet in the worship space and then move next door to King Street Cafe. On Sundays, they have the option to serve or attend the service. Those attending the service will meet their youth leaders in the back left hand section of the worship space. Those wanting to serve should meet with Pastor Scott to explore the possibilities.

### **How do Club 56 (5th-6th) and Mosaic Middle (7th-8th) work for those who attend on Thursday?**

- All 5th-8th grade will meet their Leaders at the Youth Door (located to the right of the Welcome Desk) and then join in service for worship at the beginning. Once worship ends, all student will be led to the Mosaic Game Room (downstairs) and have their lesson and connection time. You will meet your youth back in the Lobby after service.
